Definitions

- 1. Abstain: To choose not to do or participate in something, especially something enjoyable or tempting.
- 2. Campaign: A series of actions or efforts aimed at achieving a particular goal, often related to political, social, or commercial objectives.
- 3. Detain: To keep someone in custody or under restraint, often temporarily.
- 4. Entertain: To provide enjoyment, amusement, or hospitality to others, or to engage someone's attention.
- 5. Maintain: To keep something in a particular state or condition, or to support and preserve it over time.
- 6. Refrain: To hold oneself back from doing something, especially something that may be tempting or inappropriate.
- 7. Attain: To achieve or reach a desired goal or level, often through effort or ability.
- 8. Constrain: To restrict or limit the movement, action, or freedom of someone or something.
- 9. Complain: To express dissatisfaction or annoyance about something, often in an ongoing or repeated manner.
- 10. Explain: To make something clear by providing details, reasons, or descriptions to ensure understanding.
- 11. Disdain: A feeling or expression of contempt or scorn for something or someone considered unworthy or inferior.
- 12. Retain: To keep or hold onto something, especially information, an object, or a position.
- 13. Sustain: To support or maintain something, often over a period of time, or to endure through challenges.
- 14. Attainment: The act of achieving or reaching a particular goal, often a significant accomplishment or success.
